

Camden ITeC - a skills organisation which has provided a variety of training programmes to local individuals and businesses since its establishment in 1982. ITeC specialises in working with 14-19 year olds.

City Gateway – a charity that provides training and events for young people and women in the Borough of Tower Hamlets working in partnership with a range of other organisations and firms.

Executive Solutions Training Ltd - provides personal development and leadership skills for businesses, through direct training and coaching. Interactive approaches and flexible delivery options are used for training and coaching. Both small business and executive coaching are available.

Door Step Training - provides a variety of empowering, life changing courses for individuals and groups seeking to access employment and further education. Their programmes are primarily aimed at building confidence needed for further personal or professional development essential for lifelong change.

Community Advice Support Scheme - provides advice, advocacy and support services for older people and those with disabilities.

Age Concern Camden – provides employment and training advice for unemployed adults aged over 50 and living in Camden.

Wise Owls – provides training, work placements and business assistance as well as a recruitment service and employment advice for the over 45s.

Training Link – is a community learning centre in the Somers Town area of Camden who provide ESOL and IT courses as well as offering employment and volunteering advice.
